### The Next Event – July 21 – 2pm Annual General Meeting AMRA Hall

Our AGM is for the purpose of receiving reports, electing a committee for the next year and dealing with specific items of business to be determined. It has also been printed in the current edition of Back Focus which should be in your hands before the AGM.

The Society is run by the committee and we would benefit from a few new faces to assist in making decisions for the future as well as being part of the management of the monthly events. These days most of the decisions are made in an email forum and physical meetings of the committee have been largely replaced by on-line ZOOM meetings – allowing involvement from anywhere in the world. These are challenging times for the APCS and we need to change with the needs of the members and future members – so the more input we have – the better.

The form of the AGM is laid down in the rules and the required procedural items include:

- Establishment of quorum and recording of names of those in attendance and proxies.
- Apologies.
- General and financial reports.
- Determination of annual subscription.
- Date of effect of annual subscription.
- The number of committee members other than the executive for the coming year.
- Election of Committee.
- Other business for which notice has been given prior to the meeting.

Such notification shall include an instruction to vote with the Chairman or by a nominated member who must be present at the meeting. Please note the current rule that members must be financial to vote at the meetings.

The AGM is also an opportunity for social interaction between members – and don't forget the swap, sell and free tables.

### August 18 – Noon – Members-only auction AMRA Hall

An auction is planned for 18<sup>th</sup> August. Inspections will be from 2pm on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> and from 10am on the Sunday morning. All items will be photographed and you will be able to view them from the catalogue via on-line

Articles will be reformatted using Desktop Publishing Techniques.

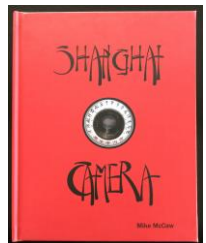
## Wanted
